Try to make your story interesting with adjectives (e.g. quick / scared / young / cold), linking words and time phrases (e.g. suddenly / some minutes later / after that).



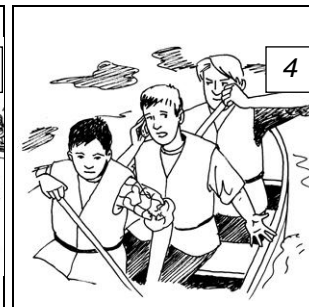
Sunny day – Jordan, Robert, Robert's uncle – go canoeing – Grand River

Water – wild



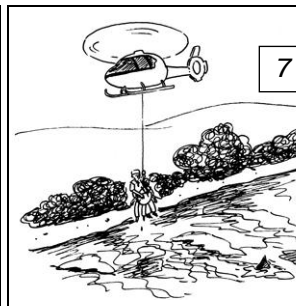
Robert – call police
